OMLA SPECTATOR'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Spectators must:

- > Treat the facilities, game officials, coaches, and players with respect
- > Accept the decisions and requests of all referees and officials
- > Remain in designated areas for spectators and leave the playing surface clear
- > Be polite, courteous and only use appropriate language

QMLA COACH'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The responsible coach will:

- > Respect the rules of the game and all Ontario Lacrosse Association (OLA) regulations
- Accept the actions of game officials and will not verbally or physically abuse an official
- > Treat all players in a respectful and equal manner
- > Ensure effective supervision of athletes before, during and after practices and games
- > Contribute to the betterment of the game
- > Ensure athletes are aware of and adhere to the "Athlete's Code of Conduct"
- > Model respect for the facilities, staff and volunteers

QMLA ATHLETE'S CODE OF CONDUCT

Any athlete participating in practices, scheduled Zone and non-Zone games, exhibition games, sanctioned events and tournament play will be expected to adhere to the following guidelines for behavior before, during and after competition.

- > Fair play is an athletes first priority
- > Respect the efforts and accomplishments of your teammates and your opponents
- Respect officials, coaches, spectators and event organizers
- > Be respectful of the facility you visit or in which you play
- > Respect the rules of the game
- Conduct yourself, at all time, with honour, dignity and mature behavior
